# Are We Tracking?

#### Synopsis

 To find a better way to handle versioning of projects that also works with the need to work locally but store on a network.

#### Ideas you have already considered

We just need a better plan

### Obstacles you are facing

 No consistent method, needing to work locally, but store projects on the network. Network speed is also slow.

## **Recording Troubles**

### Synopsis

When we create online learning, we also add voice overs. It seems that in many cases there is a last minute unpredictable edit of the voice over that must occur. When that happens and you go back days later, the voice over "sounds" different from the others in the course.
